2. ACTIVITIES

Your team will participate in practical, hands-on activities in the TERRA garden. Our head gardener Pit decides what your team will do in the garden based on the season and the garden's needs at the time.

To give you an idea of what your team could do:

Spring: prepare cultivation beds, plant Summer: plant, weed, prepare cultivation beds, harvest fruit Autumn: harvest fruit or pumpkins, weed

Your team will be accompanied by at least 1 person of our staff at all times.

3. PARTICIPANTS

In order to welcome you in the best possible way and to make your experience and impact memorable, your team can be a **maximum of 12 people**. If you are a bigger group, we suggest that you split up in teams to come on different Wednesdays.

Please note that our activities are **not accessible for people with reduced mobility**. A **good basic fitness is necessary** for our outdoor activities hands, heart & belly and heart & hands (see General Conditions).

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. HEALTH & SAFETY
- Participants recognize that the activities proposed by TERRA are outdoor activities which are exposed to bad weather and to changeable climatic conditions and which may involve some risks due to the manipulation of garden tools, to harsh terrain, or to the presence of other people and animals on the land.
- All participants have to be in a state of physical and mental health that allows them to participate in this type of activity.
- TERRA cannot be held liable for any material, moral or physical damage that a participant may suffer as a result of his/her presence and/or activity on the premises, whatever the cause of such damage.
- All participants agree to stick to the Code of Ethics of TERRA (see point 4), which is posted near the office and undertake to respect it.
- 2. CANCELLATION POLICY
- TERRA holds the right to cancel an activity up to 12 hrs in advance if the weather

conditions are unfavorable.

- An activity can be canceled by the participants' party up to seven days prior to the activity. After this delay, a cancellation fee of 50% of the total price applies. If an activity is canceled less than 24hrs in advance by the participants' party, TERRA reserves the right to charge 100% of the total fee of the activity.
- An activity canceled by TERRA can be reported to another day.
- 3. TIME POLICY
- If the start of the activity is delayed by the participants, the ending time of the activity remains as previously agreed.
- All extra time of the group at TERRA is charged at a rate of 100€/hr.
- 4. TERRA'S CODE OF ETHICS
- Respect for human rights and for nature: We are against all kinds of discourtesy, attacks and abusive language towards others. All actual or threatened violence toward or harassment of an individual or group is prohibited. We don't throw litter around TERRA's property, or the surroundings.
- Respect for everybody's safety and health: We do not tolerate conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others. It is prohibited to bring dangerous or illegal articles to TERRA.
- Education for a resilient culture that respects the soil and biodiversity: We work with nature without using pesticides, herbicides or insecticides. Our cultivation methods increase the richness of the soil and our presence in nature contributes to biodiversity, both cultivated and wild, on TERRA's property.
